

BUSINESSES IN BIERTON WITH BROUGHTON PARISH

Businesses in the parish are very diverse. There are no large businesses or major employers.

Cane End Lane has some small businesses such as Simon Taylor Furniture and two livery yards plus the recently opened Bierton Crematorium.

Burcott Lodge Farm in Burcott Lane, was the old Dairy, is currently undergoing refurbishment into several small light industrial units.

Serious Readers has an establishment in the parish on Burcott Lane in the old Methodist Church building which was converted some years ago.

The Solar Farm is situated down Gib Lane and provides, via Grantscape, small grants for village projects.

There are several builders and tradesmen operating from the villages – including heating engineer, electrician, painter and decorators.

Kirks Garage has been in the village a number of years providing a repair service, recently under new management.

Other trades and services are:

A TV and electrical repair business.

Pegasus Windows and Conservatories.

Garden machinery repairs.

Surveyors.

Car Parts.

Specialist cleaning services – window cleaning; ovens and carpets.

Several therapists provide services within the village, the largest being Cobblestones who provide chiropractic services. Others are Massage/Reiki/Healing; Physiotherapy; Reiki/Personal Training; Hairdressing, Beauty Therapy; Spray Tanning.

Dogs are well provided for in the parish with dog sitting and walking services along with an independent dog grooming service.

We have four public houses/establishments in the parish:

The Red Lion, Aylesbury Road which also has a restaurant six days per week. This is a listed building.

The Bell, Aylesbury Road has a restaurant serving Thai food during the week as well as usual pub food.

The Doghouse, Broughton, has a restaurant specialising in roasts on a Sunday.

The Barn, Hulcott is a listed building which was converted in the 1990s alongside the Aylesbury Golf Centre and driving range. The golf course has now closed but the driving range remains. The Barn is available for functions.

An area on the new Kingsbrook development has been identified for businesses but there are no details available to date.

The privately run Oakfield Community Centre is now open and contains a day nursery as well as a community hall and meeting rooms for hire.
