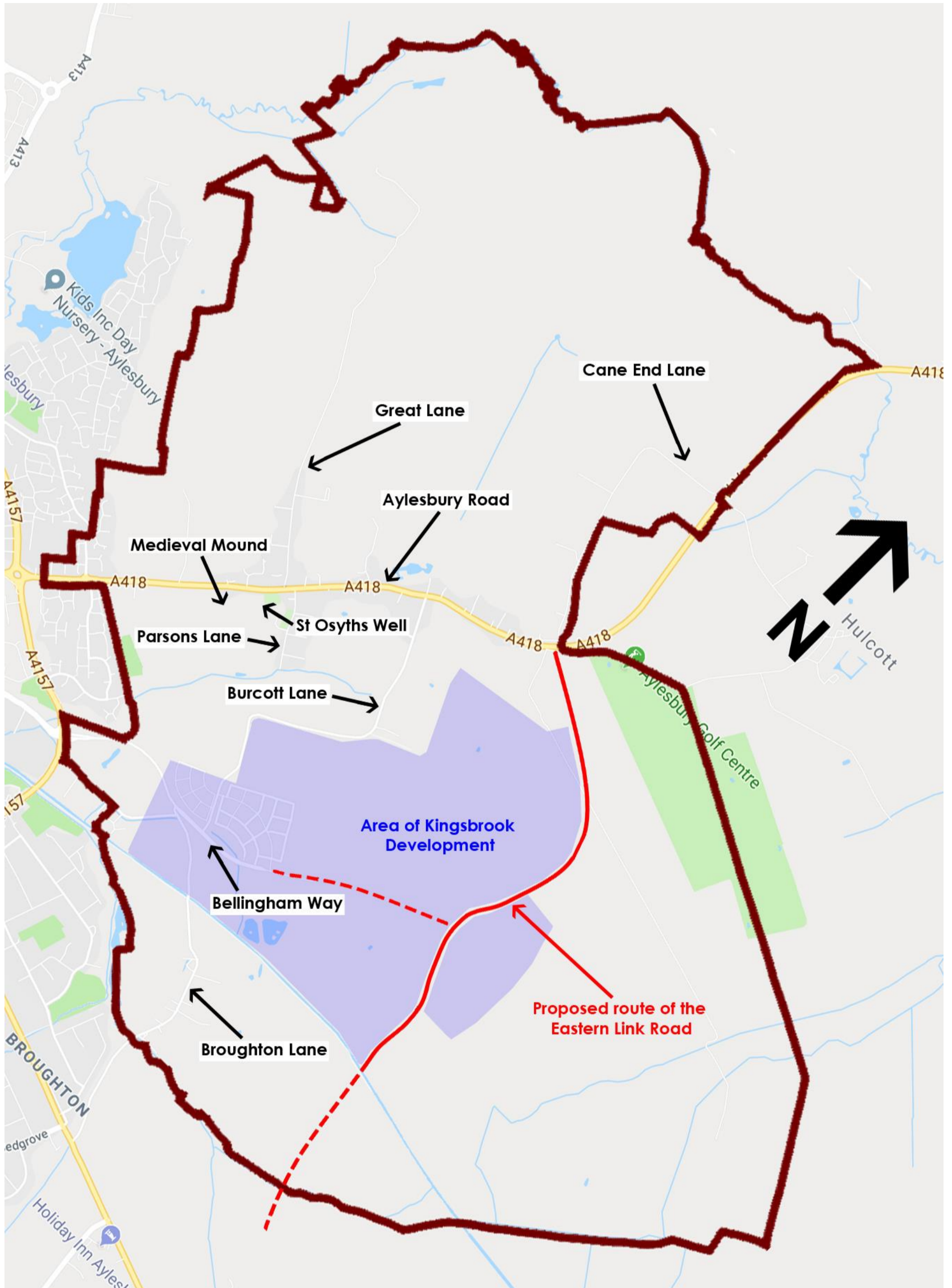

Foreword

The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group (NPSG) has worked on your behalf holding numerous consultation meetings to gather your views on your community, particularly what's important to you as the Parish grows. The Neighbourhood Plan will not stop approved development taking place, but it will influence what is developed and where development takes place. A Neighbourhood Plan is a legal document and Aylesbury Vale District Council must take it into account when considering future development within the Parish.

The NPSG was set up by the Parish Council with the aim of producing a Neighbourhood Plan to help us to:

- Control development throughout the Parish, so we aim to get the best and most appropriate growth;
- Review services and facilities needed locally and
- Protect locally important open space and heritage assets in and around the Parish.

As part of the process of gathering information to build the Plan, we need your views on what is important in the community, and how you would like to see it develop. To do this the NPSG has produced this survey. The questions that make up this survey have been prepared based on feedback that was provided at our open consultation events, as well as engagement with groups within the Parish. Full details of all engagements undertaken will be available in our Consultation and Engagement strategy.

You are encouraged to complete and submit this questionnaire using the online version or using this booklet if you cannot complete it online. All submitted questionnaires will be analysed anonymously and the NPSG will develop a draft Plan, based on the results of the questionnaire and consultation events; being what the community collectively thinks about future development within the Parish.

This plan will be developed based on the Vision that we hold for Bierton with Broughton Parish;

“To ensure Bierton with Broughton Parish maintains its historic identity whilst being a social and forward-looking community with amenities and facilities for all.”

The community will be asked to vote on the draft Plan which will also need to be approved by Aylesbury Vale District Council (AVDC) and a nationally appointed Planning Inspector.

Thank you for your time and effort in completing this questionnaire.

Our plan will be based on the information obtained from research into topics, replies from consultation events, the community, and from the responses to this questionnaire. The process will take time and there will be opportunities for you to have your say as the Plan is developed. Ultimately a local referendum will be held before the Plan is 'adopted' as a legal part of the local planning process.
